Unidiversity Youth Summer Camp (Maryville College, TN), July 19-24, 2021: Planned

1. Transportation

- Transportation to and from Unidiversity will not be provided by the church.
- Parents should make arrangements to either directly provide transportation or arrange for their youth to ride with another family.
- In cases where neither transportation option is available, a limited number of youth spots can be arranged on the FBCA luggage buses.

2. Housing

- Housing will be configured with Maryville College around single-person occupancy and small “bubbles” of youth.
- Any shared spaces (e.g., hall bathrooms) will be cleaned daily by the Maryville College staff.

3. Programming

- Unlike previous years, we will not be planning a local service project in Knoxville prior to beginning the camp.
- The camp will have a varied programming model that works to incorporate more outdoor meeting times and fewer large group gatherings.
- Camp participants will eat in small shifts in order to maintain necessary distancing and allow for proper cleaning.
- Food will be plated and served to youth by the Maryville College cafeteria staff.

4. Health Precautions

- All campers must adhere to the updated health guidelines and protocols, including the wearing of facial coverings.
- All of our FBCA programming will continue to follow the directives given by the CDC and NCDHHS, even though this event will happen in a different state.
- All retreat participants may be asked to provide a negative COVID-19 test result prior to the retreat.

5. Registration and Refunds

- Registration for Unidiversity opens January 1, 2021, with a reduced early registration rate ending January 20th.
- Families are asked to register as early as possible in order to give ample time for Unidiversity planning (particularly all necessary housing arrangements).
- Full refunds will be given to any participant who elects not to attend prior to camp. It is understandable that in the time of a global pandemic, situations change rapidly and many health factors are simply unavoidable.
